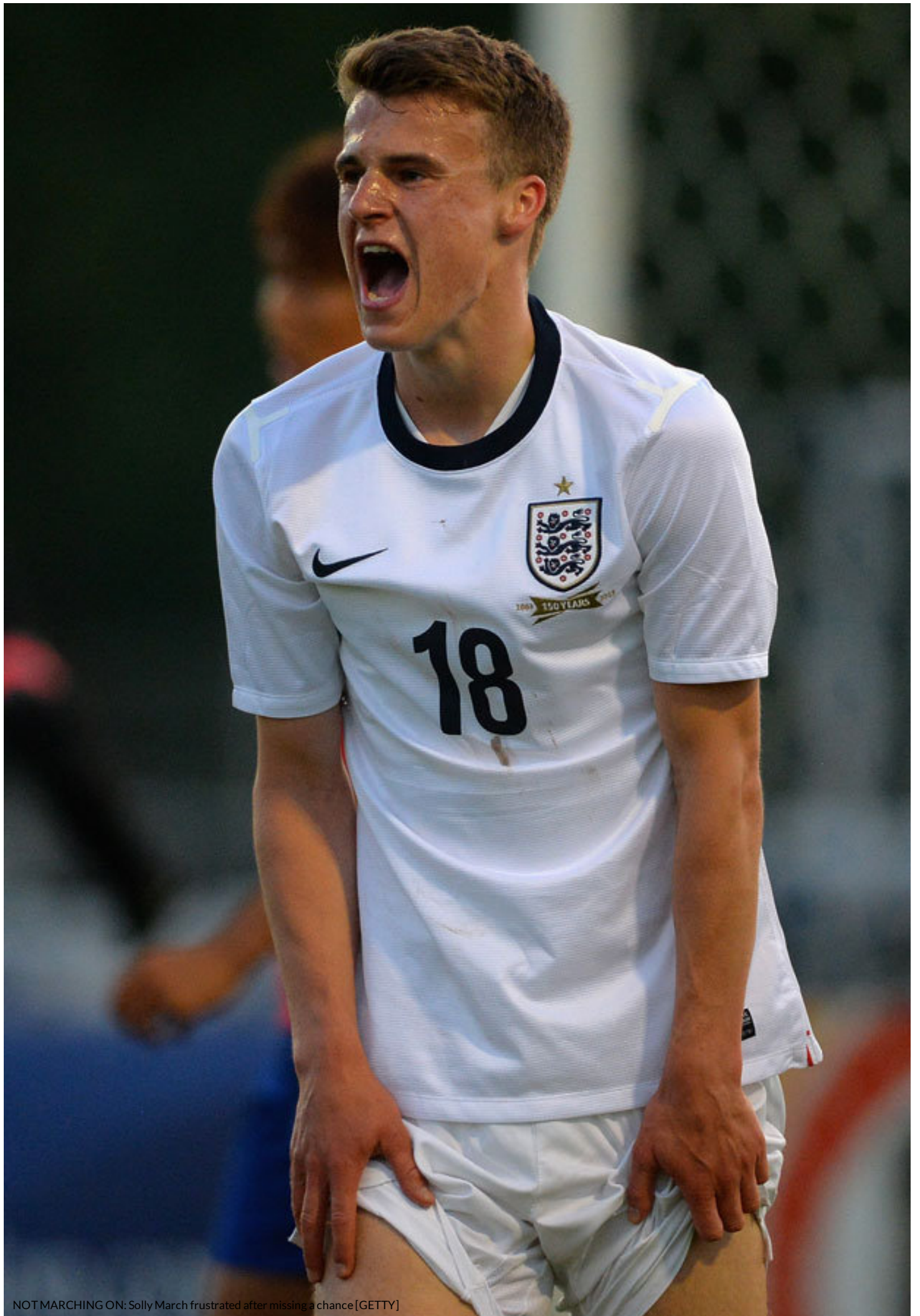
After a 2-1 defeat to Brazil on Monday ended their hopes of winning the tournament, Changmin Lee's 55th minute strike cancelled out an early Cauley Woodrow effort to leave the junior Three Lions in third place.

Now Southgate's men need at least a draw against Colombia tomorrow (Fri) to extend their stay in the south of France until the weekend.

Southgate said: "We had the chance to qualify with a win, but we haven't managed it.

"We'd rather be through and have it all done and dusted and the players will all be frustrated.

"Unfortunately we've played four games this summer and conceded sloppy goals in all of them. Some days that will cost you and it has tonight."
