# 5 Youngsters Maurizio Sarri Could Sign For Juventus This January

Following the capture of Dejan Kulusevski from Atlanta, Maurizio Sarri will be on the lookout for further additions to his squad this winter.

The Juve boss could turn to some of Europe's brightest talent as he looks to build the Turin-based side for the future.

Players are also expected to depart this month, leaving room for new additions. Here are five starlets the Old Lady could look to sign.

## Sandro Tonali (Brescia)

The 19-year-old Brescia midfielder is already being considered as the new Andrea Pirlo. The former Juventus midfielder also started his career with the Northern Italian side.

Strong, energetic, elegant, the creative Tonali, has excellent vision and an ability to read the game, similar to that of Pirlo. Having broken into the Brescia first-team at the age of 17, he can play in a central or defensive midfield role as well as a being deployed as a deep-lying playmaker.

Tonali has claimed Steven Gerrard and Luka Modrić to be his idols and has also compared his own playing style to Gennaro Gattuso. In October last year, the youngster made his senior Italy international bow in a 5-0 away win against Liechtenstein in a Euro 2020 qualifier.

Juventus will have to battle it out with Manchester City, Paris Saint-Germain, Atlético Madrid, Inter Milan and Manchester United for the youngsters' services.

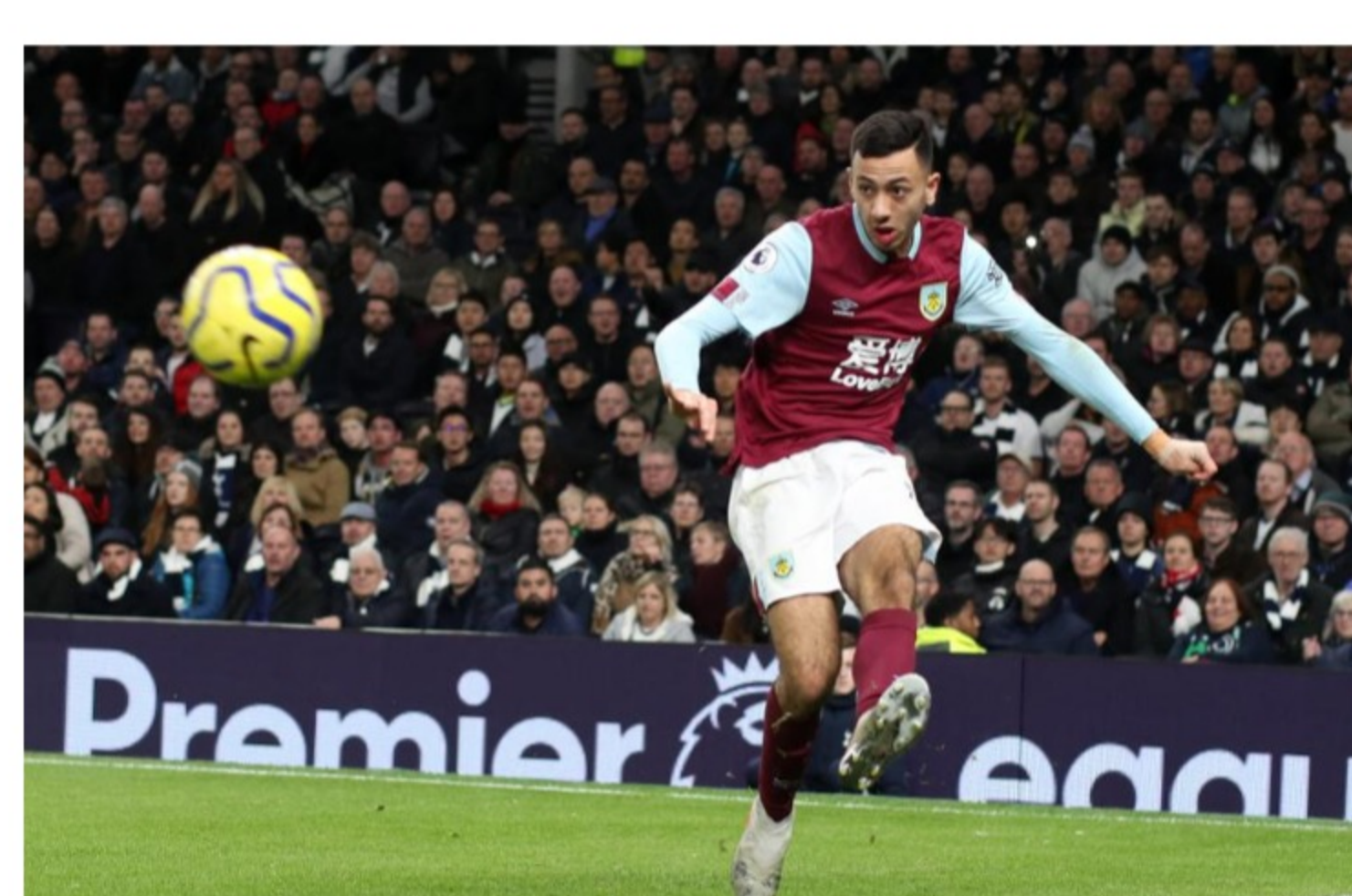

Having impressed in last summer's Under-17 European Championship for England, scoring three goals in three games, the 17-year-old caught the eye of scouts from both Juve and AC Milan.

Sarri's side have previously raided the Gunners for youngster Stephy Mavididi, who is currently on-loan at Dijon and could now turn their attention to Greenwood.

AC Milan executive Ivan Gazidis knows all about the number nine, who can also feature as a winger, having worked at Arsenal previously and could persuade the Sunderland-born teenager to join.

## Dwight McNeil (Burnley)



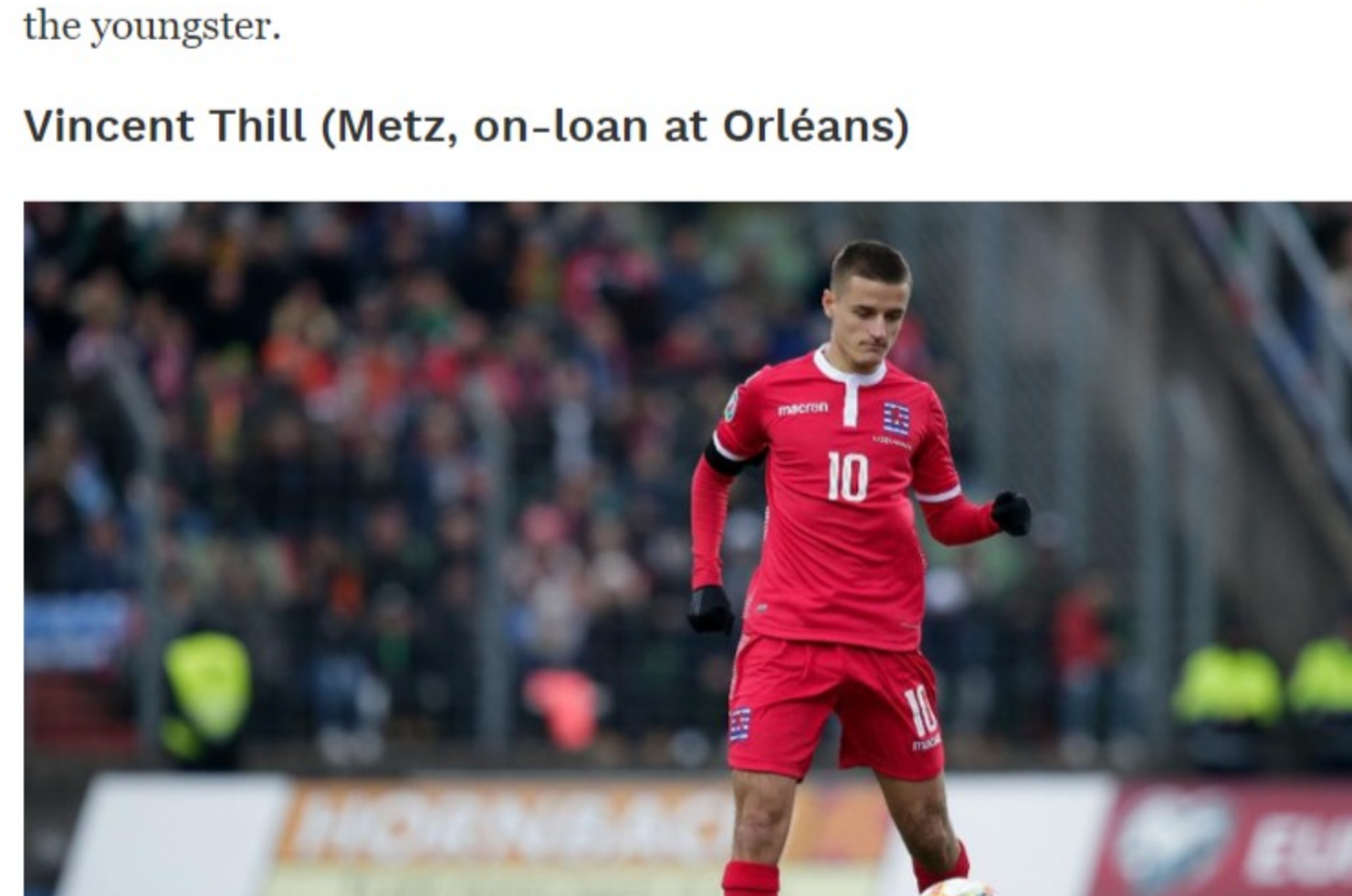

Juventus remain keen on the Burnley winger who has netted three goals and five assists from 21 outings for the Clarets in the Premier League.

The 19-year-old impressed with England Under-20s during the Toulon Tournament in France last year which alerted chiefs from the Serie A champions.

Burnley have slapped a \$39million price tag on McNeil to fend off any interest. Juventus, however, will test their resolve and look to swoop for the youngster.

## Vincent Thill (Metz, on-loan at Orléans)



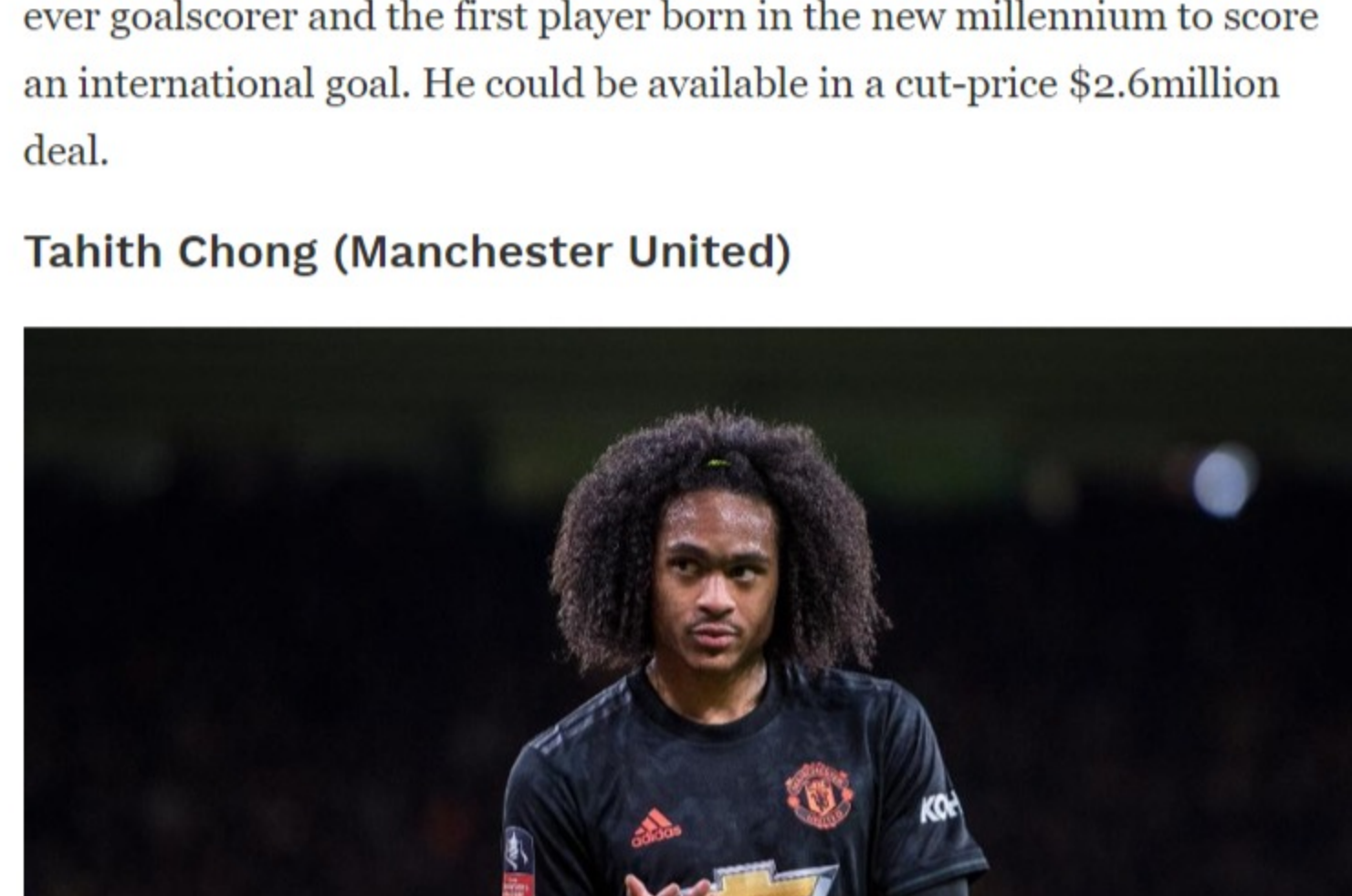

A previous target for West Ham, Juve remain keen on the Luxembourg starlet. The 19-year-old made his first-team debut for Metz as a 16-year-old which originally alerted European giants Bayern Munich.

The attacking midfielder became the youngest player to represent his nation on the international stage making his debut at a remarkable 16-years-old back in 2016 against Bosnia.

Scoring against Nigeria in the same year, he became his nation's youngest ever goalscorer and the first player born in the new millennium to score an international goal. He could be available in a cut-price \$2.6million deal.

## Tahith Chong (Manchester United)

Juventus are \$2.6million suitors and prepared to offer the Old Trafford teen sensation \$2.6million plus \$45,000-a-week deal to swap Manchester for Turin.

Out of contract at the end of the season, the 20-year-old is yet to agree a new deal with Ole Gunnar Solskjær's side and could leave on a free when his contract expires this summer.

Chong is now available to talk any clubs outside of the Premier League, suggesting a move is likely to happen. The right-winger, who started his career at Feyenoord before moving to Manchester United in 2016, has made just four appearances in two seasons at Old Trafford and is keen on a move away as he targets regular minutes.
